*The Rufus Porter Museum* hosts a fascinating tour of 10 sites in and around Bridgton, a picturesque town in Southwestern Maine.

Tour 10 historic properties, staffed with knowledgeable docents enjoying Bridgton's architectural styles from vernacular to Italianate.

*The Rufus Porter Museum* celebrates the life and times of Rufus Porter, a giant of the 19<sup>th</sup> Century, who established a presence in Bridgton as a young itinerate painter.

For the 2011 season, *the Rufus Porter Museum* offers a special exhibit of 19<sup>th</sup> Century weathervanes, tours of Porter's murals, and a 5-day Cultural Heritage Series in late July.
